Subject: Transfer drive of Group D employees who are covered under Haryana Group D Employees (Recruitment & Conditions of Service) Act, 2018.

Sir/ Madam,

I am directed to invite yours attention to this department letter no. 22/82/2022-2CC-I, dated 09.11.2022 on the subject noted above, vide which concept note about transfer drive in respect of Group D employees who are covered under the Group D Employee (Recruitment & Conditions of Service) Act, 2018 was placed in public domain for suggestions from all the departments. After considering the suggestions received from the different departments at length, the State Government has finalized the transfer drive policy of aforementioned employees; follow as under:-

I. Background and Objective of the Transfer Drive:

The Government of Haryana vide notification dated 28.3.2018 enacted the Haryana Group D Employees (Recruitment and Conditions of Service) Act, 2018 (here-in- after referred to as the Group D Act). Thereafter more than 18000 posts were filled up by direct recruitment through Haryana Staff Selection Commission.

After the passing of time, it has been observed that some persons appointed on Group D posts are facing difficulties in performing their duties efficiently. Some of the employees have been posted at far flung places from their hometown. Keeping in view their hardship, the Government has decided to launch a Transfer Drive to give an opportunity to all the group D employees of common cadre for transfer/adjusting in an office near their hometown and on a suitable post.

The main object of this transfer drive is to remove hardship of the employees regarding their station of posting, and also adjustment on the posts other than the posts on which they do not deem themselves fit for appointment.

- (a) For this purpose, each employee will have to select three Districts where she/he wants to be posted / transferred.
- (b) She/he will also have to select maximum 50 posts on which she/he does not

deem herself/himself fit to work out of the list of all Group D posts.

- (c) In this Drive, efforts will be made to transfer the employee at any one of the three Districts selected by him on priority basis, and, not to transfer him to the posts on which she / he is not ready to work.
- (e) However, it will not be guaranteed that the employee will be able to get the District of his/her choice or avoid the posts he/she does not deem fit for herself/himself. The employee shall not be able to claim a right based on his/her choices filled on the portal.

II. Eligibility: Employees eligible to participate in the Transfer Drive

- (a) In this Transfer Drive, all the Group D employees appointed on regular basis after the enactment of Group D Act and posted in any Department of Haryana Government are eligible to participate.
- (b) However, the Group D employees posted in any Statutory Body/ Board/ Corporation/Public Sector Undertaking / Constitutional Body are not eligible to participate in this drive.
- (c) The employees whose writ petitions bearing No. 12419 of 2022 titled as Rajender Singh & Ors Vs State of Haryana, No. 7388 of 2022- titled as Shiv Kumar& Ors Vs State of Haryana and CWP No. 26229 of 2022 titled as Monika and Ors Vs State of Haryana, wherein stay orders on transfers of petitioners have been granted and are pending before the Hon'ble Punjab & Haryana High Court, Chandigarh, shall not be eligible to participate in the transfer drive. If any of the petitioners participates in the transfer drive knowingly or unknowingly, he/she will be solely responsible for any adverse consequences.
- (d) Only those eligible employees who want to change their station and / or their post, and participate in online transfer drive on the portal within 15 days after the availability of online portal, which will be intimated lateron
- (e) An employee, who fails to register and apply on the portal by the said date, will not be considered eligible.
- (f) The employees under Common Cadre recruited on the technical posts of Group D in Transport Department are excluded from the Transfer Drive.

III. Criteria of Transfer from one Station to another or from one post to another:

The employees who participate in this Transfer Drive shall be adjusted / transferred from one station to another and/or from one post to another within the same or any other Department

- (1) Persons currently working against the posts of Sweeping nature, e.g., Sewerman, Peon-cum-Sweeper, Sanitary Worker, Jamadar etc.
- (2) Persons with disabilities, subject to adjustment against the identified post.
- (3) Persons working on semi-skilled posts, to adjust them on unskilled posts.
- (4) Widow/Widower/Divorced employee having children, provided not remarried.
- (5) Childless widow / childless divorced female employee / unmarried female employee.
- (6) Wives of Military and Para-Military Personnel.
- (7) Couple case in which the spouse of the Group D employee is working in any Department / Board / Corporation under Govt. of India / State Government.
- (8) Female employees.
- (9) Male employees.

Notes:

- (a) Within each category the employees will be prioritized based on "age" keeping in view their date of birth. For example, out of two or more employees of same category, the preference shall be given to the oldest/older one. If the date of birth is same then the number in merit list will be taken into account.
- (b) Two or more categories of priorities will not be clubbed, e.g., if a disabled employee is also a childless widow she will first be considered in the category of disabled persons, if she does not get success then she will be considered again in the list of interested employees of the category of childless widow/divorced female employees.
- (c) "Judicially Separated" employees shall not be clubbed with divorced employee. He/she shall be considered in their respective categories i.e. female employee/male employee.
- (d) A remarried Widow/Widower must opt for "Married" option under Marital Status of HRMS records, and shall not apply under the category of "Widow / Widower / Divorced employee having children".

IV. PROCESS TO BE FOLLOWED FOR TRANSFER/POSTING OF GROUP D EMPLOYEES

The process includes following five main steps for transfer:-

- (1) Category wise grouping of employees/participants
- (2) Calculation of percentage share of employee for each category of employees
- (3) Calculation of Total number of vacant posts District wise for all categories of employees/participants
- (4) Transfer/Posting in the District as per their choice

(1) Category wise grouping of employees/participants:-

Let's suppose 5,000 Group D employees participated in this Transfer Drive and the category wise employee segregation is as per table given below:-

(2) Calculation of percentage share of employee for each category of employees:-

Out of 5000 total participants, 250 participants of the Sweeping Nature want their transfer from the existing post. In order to distribute the vacant posts at an equal rate among all categories, first of all the percentage share of each category of employees will be calculated keeping in view the number of participants of each category divided by total number of participants of all categories as per calculation given below:-

Total number of participants of sweeping nature employees	250

(3) Calculation of total number of posts District wise for all categories of employees/participants:-

Let's suppose: out of these 250 participants working to a post of Sweeping nature, 25 participants want their posting/transfer in any office in Ambala District on any post other than the post of sweeping nature. For this purpose the vacant posts will be divided by percentage share of the respective category of employees/participants. The percentage share of the employees of

Sweeping nature is 5%, so the 5% of the posts lying vacant in Ambala District will be worked out

Transfer/Posting in the District as per their choice: (4)

For transfer of 25 Group D employees presently working the posts of sweeping nature, the Group D post of Peon having highest number of vacancies will be earmarked to the first four eligible participant of this category provided this post does not cover under the list of the posts on which they do not indeed intended to work. In case one of the four participants is not intending to work on the post of Peon he/she will be considered for next post in the list of vacant posts i.e. Lab. Attendant. Thereafter, next 3 participants will be posted/transferred to the post of Lab. Attendant in Ambala District provided this post does not cover under the list of the posts on which they do not indeed intended to work and so on.

V. Undertaking from participating employees:

Every Group D employee who participated in this Transfer Drive shall have to give an undertaking as under :-

VI. General Clauses:

- (a) For this transfer drive, the posts presently lying vacant, other than the advertised posts, will also be taken into consideration. So, the total posts for this drive will be equal to total vacant posts available on H.R.M.S. plus the posts equal to number of employees who participate in this drive.
- (b) Duly verified employee data will serve as input for "Post Mapping Algorithm".

(c)	Training details of employee will not be considered for this drive.
(d)	No option for preference of post shall be allowed to the participants in this Transfer Drive, therefore, one may be transferred against any post or which she/he is intending to work
(e)	If there is any semi-skilled post(s) in the unselected list of posts of a participant already working on unskilled post, she/he will be given preference to transfer against unskilled to semi-skilled post rather than the participant of same category/district who want transfer from unskilled to unskilled post.
(f)	While calculating the age of a participant for the purpose of determining priority in case of a "tie", the 1 st of January, 2023 will be considered the cut off date for this purpose.
(g)	This transfer will be treated as transfer on the request of Government employee and no Transfer TA/DA or Joining Time shall be admissible on transfer from one station to another.

VII. Process to be followed by the Participants:

Following process shall have to be followed by the eligible participants for transfer from one District to another and/or from one post to another:

1.	Firstly by wa	, the eligible employees shall log into the portal at y of their "ESalary ID"	
2.	There will be an OTP based authentication and employee will get OTP for verification on the Mobile Phone Number already registered on HRMS.		
3.	After s	successful authentication, user will go to the Home Page of the Porta the employee's details already available on HRMS record will be shown	
4.	If any employee who is not eligible for this Transfer Drive, but participate or log into the portal, in such case HRMS API will send error code and message will be shown to the user on the portal.		
5.	After su	accessful authentication, the Employee will have to provide the following tion on the portal:	
	(a)	Employees will have the option to select maximum 3 three districts where she/he prefers to work. Panchkula will be divided into two	

	parts, i.e., Head Offices at Panchkula or field offices situated in the District of Panchkula.
(b)	Employees will have the option to select maximum 50 posts where he/she is not willing to work out of the list of Group D posts available on the portal.
(c)	In case of Widow / Widower / Divorced employee who have not remarried and having children, he / she has to inform the number of child(ren);
(d)	All the employees shall have to submit an undertaking and consent, displayed on the portal.

VIII. Verification of information from the Department:

The information made available by the employee will be got verified from the Head of Department concerned.

1.	The information provided by the employee on the portal will be sent to the concerned Head of Department for verification and the concerned Department in turn, after verification of the data shall give an undertaking that the data has been duly checked and is found to be correct.
2.	Complete list of successful validated employees as well as the employees whose information was found to be erroneous/ incomplete will be published on the portal.
3.	In case of incorrect/ incomplete information, concerned employee will be asked to provide the correct information on the portal and to give justification against the incorrect/ flagged information.
4	Thereafter, edited /modified information will again be sent to the Department for 're-verification.'
5.	Duly verified and validated data will serve as input for the Transfer Algorithm.

IX. Detail of employee derived from HRMS:

On completion of the above process, following details of the employee (user) shall be displayed which will be derived from the HRMS portal. These details will be non-editable.

XI. Compliance of Transfer Orders:

- a) Upon the issue of transfer order, the employee will stand automatically relieved from the post earlier occupied by him/her.
- b) All the Head of Departments/Head of Offices shall be bound to relieve the employee on her/his transfer, whether he is ready to relinquish the charge or not, or whether the Department needs the employee or not, and immediately allow to join the new person transferred into the post.
- c) Upon transfer of a person at the station and to a post, she / he has to join at the new station, otherwise, disciplinary action will be taken against him/her.

XII. Clarification:

In this Transfer Drive there will be no option to select a Department/Office, there will be an

option to select three Districts only priority-wise and maximum 50 such posts on which she/he does not indeed intends to work.

XIII. The list of Group D posts for transfer drive is annexed as Annexure-A.

XIV. The above policy may kindly be brought to the notice of all concerned.
